- 4. How can we see from this passage that rejection is promised? How did Jesus know He would be rejected? (Mark 8:31?) What does this tell you about Jesus? How do we know that Christ's followers will be rejected? (John 15:19-20, 1 Peter 4:11-16) How is this information helpful to you in dealing with rejection?
- 5. How can we see from this passage that rejection is painful? (See also Isaiah 53:2-3, Psalm 22:6, Psalm 69:4, 9, 19-21) What does this tell you about Jesus? How is remembering that rejection is painful helpful when we are rejected?
- 6. How can we see from this passage that rejection is profitable? How did Christ's rejection profit Him? How does being rejected for Christ's sake profit us? (Hebrews 12:1-11, Matt. 5:11-12)
